

The Frayer Model

Definition	Characteristics
<p>Student-friendly description of the term (usually provided by your teacher)</p>	<p>Facts or features that help you recognize, identify, or distinguish the term</p>
term	
Examples	Nonexamples
<p>An example must be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A specific, real-world application of the term• Something that fits all of the characteristics of the term	<p>A nonexample must be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• An incorrect, or inappropriate, real-world application of the term• Related to the term but not an example of the term• Something that does not fit all of the characteristics of the term

Example of a Completed Frayer Model

Definition	Characteristics
Showing great care and concern	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Thoughtful• Kind• Helpful• Generous and caring to those in need
compassion	
Examples	Nonexamples
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Giving food to the hungry• Comforting sick children	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Greeting or welcoming others• Bagging groceries
