Specific Questions



- 1. Read a "chunk" of text.
- 2. Write a specific or wide question about important information or facts.
- 3. Answer the question and cite textual evidence.
- Questions can be answered in one word or one sentence.
- Answers can be found word for word in the text.
- Example: What is the largest ocean?
- Questions can be answered using information from multiple places in the text or by making inferences.
- Answers require one or more sentences.
- *Example:* How was the experience of the colonists different from what they expected?
